# The grammar of data merging

The 5 verbs of data wrangling

**inner\_join()** # take a subset of columns

**left\_join()** # take a subset of rows

**right\_join()** # add or modify existing columns

**full\_join()** # sort the rows

**bind\_rows()**

**bind\_cols()**
