Guidelines for the preparation of Homework Solutions:

Your homework solutions should include the following:

1. All scanned pages should have your name at the top, clearly visible.

2. Title of the Homework, for example, Homework 1 should be clearly stated at the top of the first page.

3. Each problem should be notated. For example, if problem 18 is assigned, your work for problem 18 should start with 18 clearly written to the left of your page where your work begins.

4. Your work should be presented in the order that it was assigned. Problem 18 should appear before Problem 19, for example.

5. All book problems should be presented before any computer Exercises.

6. All problems from the book, unless the use of a computer is needed, should be worked by hand. Hand written solutions are acceptable and such problems do not need to be typeset in an R Quarto document.

7. For the preparation of an R Quarto Notebook, the YAML header can be used to create a self-contained .html file. A self-contained .html file can be uploaded to Canvas and will be visible to the instructor.
